InDesign is much easier to create multipage PDF files in consistent Pages navigation. Make sure to include visual indicators for navigation (forward, Content next, back, home, etc.) Add Bookmark 2. Save or export your file as a PDF 🖉 Attach a File 3. Open newly created PDF in Acrobat Professional 4. Open the tools panel using the button on the right top menu bar. If the Edit Text & Objects content section is collapsed, expand it. About half-way down in the content menu is Add or Edit Interactive Object. The top choice is Link, T Edit Document Text this will be the main tool you use to link to external files, navigate from Edit Object page to page and connect to web pages. 5. Select the link tool, draw a link box around one of your navigation Add or Edit Text Box indicators and wait for the pop-up box. In this first box, set the Add or Edit Interactive Object appearance of your rollover and overall link.
